Guidelines:

1. Kendall County 4-H participants only.
2. Senior showmanship champion and reserve champion from the Beef, Sheep, and Swine livestock 4-H project are entered in the contest.
3. Any livestock exhibitor who is entering their last two years of 4-H and would like to compete in the Master Showmanship contest, no matter what has transpired in the species judging this year or the two previous years, may participate in the annual contest at the county fair level.
4. Winner would represent Kendall County at the Illinois State Fair.
5. The winner (14 years of age or older at the time of the state event) will be chosen at the Kendall County Fair & 4-H Show to attend the IL State Fair Master Showmanship Contest. If winner can't attend, the alternate will be chosen to go.

Participants are encouraged to stay and help set up ring after the Auction on Saturday.

CONTEST LEVELS

Level A: Ages 6 years – 8 years: Trophy & Rosette

Level B: Ages 4 years – 5 years: Trophy & Rosette

Guidelines:

1. **Open to any participant that meets the age requirements, not exclusive to swine exhibitors.**
2. Participants cannot be members of 4-H. **Cloverbuds are welcome and encouraged to participate.**
3. Participants will provide the pig to show for contest: Animal could be the pig they entered in open show or a pig they arranged to use from another exhibitor. Animal must be already at the fair and processed through health check and registration.
4. All participants will need to sign a waiver prior to participating in the contest. Parent or guardian consent is required.
5. All participants will receive ribbons provided by the Kendall County Fair Association.
6. Participants will be expected to show the pig around the ring at the judge's direction.
