# TABLE SETTINGS



Table setting **MUST** be set up by the exhibitor – *no exceptions*.

1. Table setting shall be set on a standard card table, **provided by the exhibitor**.
2. Table to be set for two places.
3. Table must be covered with appropriate tablecloth or covering.
4. The centerpiece may be made of fresh, dried, or artificial materials. Proper flatware must be used.
5. Exhibitors may use props (mannequins, etc.) to highlight their table settings.
6. Each entrant must include a menu list, to be displayed on table.
7. Care will be taken to ensure safety of all equipment and materials used, but the Fair shall not be responsible for any loss.

3. Entries may not be shown more than 2 consecutive years. All exhibits must be suitable for display in showcase. Entries which have won 1<sup>st</sup> premium in this department at the Kendall County Fair are not eligible to compete.
4. All possible care of the exhibits will be taken. However, the Kendall County Fair cannot be Responsible for loss or damage to exhibits.
5. **All exhibits will be placed in display area by superintendents.**
