**Entry must be submitted on or before Thursday, July 12, 2018.**

1. All classes will be judged on quality, uniformity and attractiveness.
2. Trim the top of all root vegetables down to ½ - ¾ inch. Also trim the long root of root vegetables.
3. Wash all vegetables lightly. Vegetables will be exhibited on a 9" white paper plate provided by the exhibitor.
4. All exhibits **MUST** have been grown during the current year by the exhibitor except dry grains, which can be from the previous year.

#### \* Description for Market Basket Display:

- a) Must be eight (8) and not more than twelve (12) different kinds of vegetables.
- b) Number of vegetables used must conform to those listed in classes 9800-9823(Senior) and 10000-10023(Junior)
- c) Baskets will be provided. Entrants must arrange display upon arrival at fair.
- d) Display must be labeled with name and variety of vegetables.
- e) Display must be two feet square.
- f) Market Basket will also be judged on assortment and arrangement.
