Entry must be submitted on or before Monday, July 12, 2018.

1. Bring all cut flowers in water ready to transfer into vases provided by the Kendall County Fair Association. Vases will be provided for classes 7300-7475(Junior) and 5200-5221(Senior).
2. Conditioning-cut flowers will stay fresh longer if they are conditioned ahead of time. Cut your flowers in the cool of the morning or evening and submerge the stems in warm water. Place them in a cool. Draft free place for 3-4 hours before arranging or exhibiting.
3. Potted plants – pot size not to exceed 15" in diameter and MUST be grown by the exhibitor.
4. Potted plants will be judged in accordance with shape, health, vigor, quantity and quality of flowers (if any).
5. Exhibits will be maintained during the Fair, but the Fair Association and superintendents in no way assume responsibility for them. There will be no storage space available for boxes, etc.
6. No entry can be exhibited more than once, if it has been exhibited in previous years at the Kendall County Fair.
7. Entry must be the work of the exhibitor. Previously entered items are not acceptable.
8. Exhibitors may enter only one (1) entry per class.
